

CHAPARRAL DAILY ROUTINES

REGULAR SCHOOL DAY

6:45-8:25	Children participate in supervised “free play” which consists of a variety of centre based activities, including crafts, puzzles, floor toys, dramatic play, and outdoor activities. Children cleanup activities and prepare to leave for school. Children are welcome to bring cereal from home for breakfast at this time.
8:25 – 8:40	Children in grades 1-6 tidy up, get ready and leave for school. Children are under the supervision of school staff until the bell rings.
8:40-9:00	Kindergarten children are encouraged to participate in planned leader led activities for the day and in supervised “free play” activities. Cranston & Our Lady Of The Rosary Kindertartens arrive.
9:00-9:30	Kindergarten children clean up their areas, wash their hands, and have morning snack.
9:30-11:30	Kindertartens participate in activity based centres that the children may choose from. These activities may include dramatic play, arts and crafts, group games, board games, puzzles, floor toys, sensory games and reading. 11:45 – 12:10	Cranston & Our Lady of the Rosary Kindertartens board the centre bus and are driven back to school.
11:30-12:05	Chaparral Kindertartens clean up their areas, wash their hands, and have lunch
12:05-12:25	Kindertartens tidy up and get ready for school. The staff will walk the children to the school.
12:50 – 3:20	Special activities such as field trips, guest speakers, theme and movie days and often lunch off site. For days at centre, specialty art activities, outdoor play and games are planned. All activity centres are open for children to engage in play of their choosing.
